Doug Meehan to be VIP at Blossoms at the Beebe
to be held on April 29th

(Wakefield, MA) – NewsCenter 5’s Doug Meehan, co-anchor of the weekday morning EyeOpener newscasts will be the VIP at the upcoming *Blossoms at the Beebe* at the Lucius Beebe Memorial Library. The VIP reception, an invitation-only event for Blossoms at the Beebe sponsors, is held before the start of the event.

The adults-only gala, co-sponsored by the Lucius Beebe Memorial Library and the Wakefield Lynnfield Chamber of Commerce, will be held on Saturday evening, April 29th from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. Proceeds from the event help sustain important programs at the Library as well as community projects sponsored by the Wakefield Lynnfield Chamber of Commerce.

Before co-anchoring the weekday EyeOpener, Doug was co-anchor of WCVB’s weekend EyeOpener newscasts. He joined WCVB in December 2015 from KPNX-TV in Phoenix, AZ where he served for nearly three years as a news anchor.

Well known in New England, Doug was host of “The Doug Meehan Show” on Boston's WTKK 96.9 FM as well as a contributor on The Wall Street Journal Radio Network in New York. He was a reporter and anchor at Boston’s WFXT-TV where he was the market’s first full-time helicopter reporter covering traffic as well as breaking news, and worked at Boston’s WHDH-TV as a reporter and relief anchor. For six years before that, Doug’s long career in broadcast journalism includes working at WFAA-TV and KTVT-TV in Dallas, TX; WTSP-TV,

Tampa, FL, and KEYE-TV in Austin, TX, WPRI-TV in Providence, RI, and at New England Cable News. He began his news career as an anchor and reporter at Cape 11 News in South Yarmouth, MA.

This year's gala will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Library's opening and will feature a Centennial Jubilee theme with a flower show, special musical entertainment, dancing on both levels of the Library, gourmet hors d'oeuvres, a silent auction and a cash bar.
